

Since placing our "Free First Trimester Ultrasound" sign in front of the center, we have had dozens of new clients come into the center saying that they never knew what the Carlisle Area Family Life Center was until they saw that sign. We are grateful to Karen Comello, who has kept our windows beautifully decorated for each season; however, our Board of Directors made the decision that we should use our windows to advertise the center. Thus, CAFLC has used the donations given to the center in memory of Carol Glabus, our former director who passed away last July to purchase window screens that inform the community of our services and upcoming events and fundraisers. Carol was always very diligent in promoting the center via advertisements in local newspapers, yearbooks, phone books, restaurant placemats, and even on television.

Thus, it seemed fitting to honor her in a way that would further increase awareness of the center in our community.

On July 31st at 10 am., a plaque honoring Carol will be placed on the wall of the CAFLC reception room near the newly installed screens. Current and former volunteers and board members, friends, and family are welcome to join us to share stories and memories of our beloved former director.

## "Match Madness" Saves the Day!

As the new year dawned and COVID cases increased, the CAFLC "Celebrate Life" fundraising committee realized that the center would not be able to hold its annual "Bingo for Babies" this spring. We were not sure how we would replace these needed funds... then prayers were answered. The Carlisle Area Family Life Center was invited to participate in The Partnership for Better Health's Sixth Annual "Match Madness" fundraiser. CAFLC along with 51 other nonprofits were able to raise funds that were matched by the Josiah W. and Bessie H. Kline Foundation, M&T Bank along with the Partnership for Better Health. The first \$1,000 raised was matched dollar for dollar and then the remaining \$130,000 in matching funds were shared proportionately among the groups. CAFLC was able to raise \$10,725 in donations and \$2601.15 in matching funds which totaled \$13,326.15. We are so grateful to everyone who supported the center in our first Match Madness!

### **Ultrasound Update**



Jen, our Ultrasound Nurse/Manager continues to be a blessing to our clients and the center. It is so important to be able to offer a client who may be considering an abortion the opportunity to see her baby and see his/her heart beating. As Jen has remarked, the abortion determined clients refuse to even look at their ultrasound because they know that it would probably change their mind! During this winter when cases were high and hope was low, we did have a couple of clients who were considering an abortion. We were able to do an ultrasound, maybe even a couple of them and last we heard; they were still planning on having their babies!

Jen has also been able to assist quite a few of our clients through the early loss of their baby and others who are again pregnant after a loss and need some reassurance. She also regularly helps our clients to obtain medical assistance to begin prenatal care as soon as possible. This is another process that has been complicated by COVID closures! Jen is enjoying doing scans so much that soon she will be doing them a couple more days a week on a mobile ultrasound unit recently purchased by Undefeated Courage. We wish them all the best as they begin their mission!
